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# Introduction

The MAPS Applications (Argos, IntelCheck, FormFusion, MAP Server Configuration) use ActiveX to load a cab file on the client machine to launch the applications. ActiveX is a Microsoft product that is installed with Internet Explorer. ActiveX is not natively supported in Google Chrome; therefore software extensions to the browser are required for it to work with MAPS.

The software extensions are developed by third parties and are not supported or endorsed by Evisions. This information is provided solely as a convenience to you and not as an endorsement by Evisions of the developer or content of the software extensions.

This document outlines the steps required to install extensions to Google Chrome so it will function with MAPS applications.

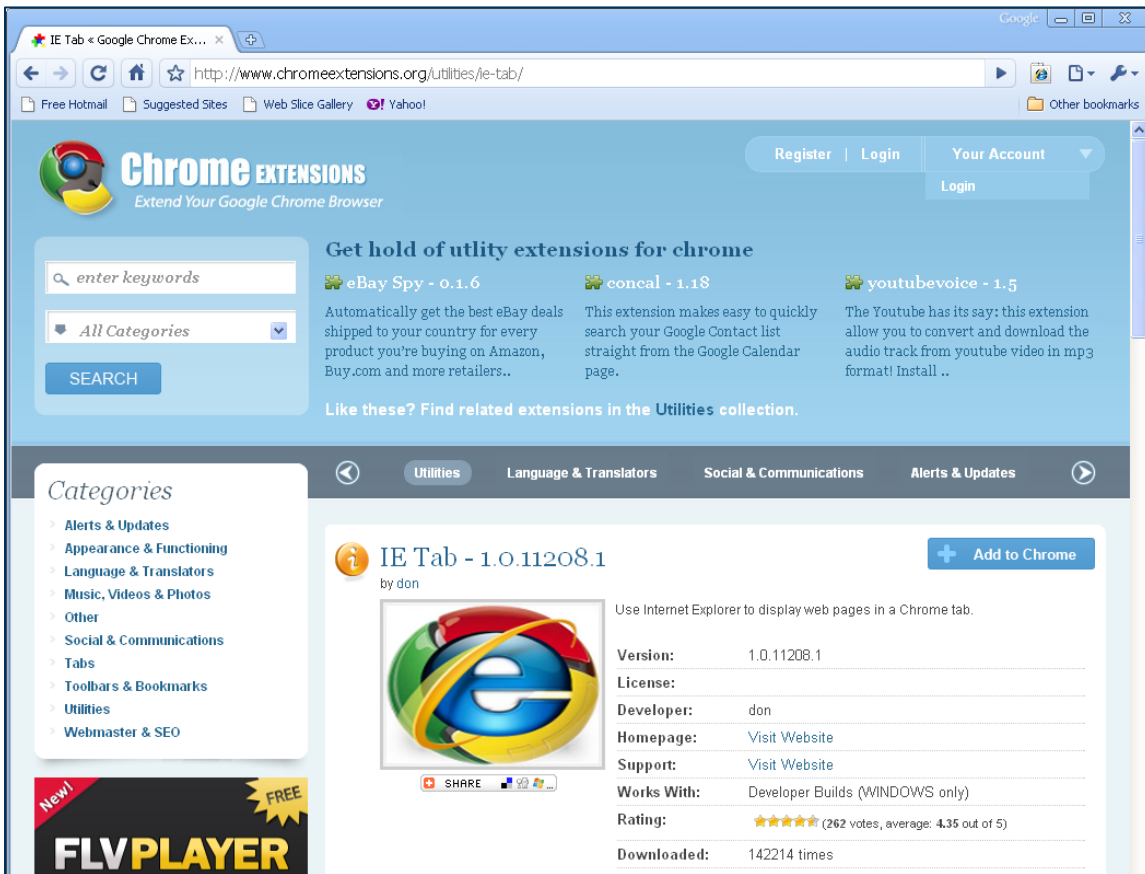

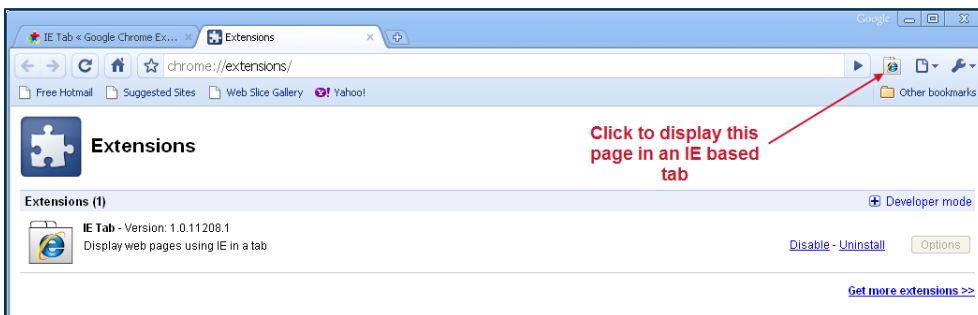
# Download and Install Extension to Google Chrome

Launch Chrome and navigate to <http://www.chromeextensions.org/utilities/ie-tab/>.

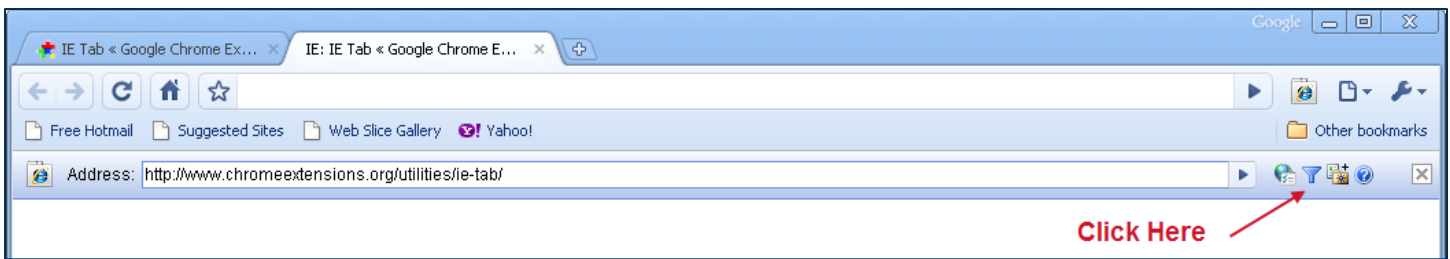
Click the blue “Add to Chrome” button shown in the figure below. The extension will be added to Chrome without further action on your part.



After the extension has been installed, click the Internet Explorer icon shown in the figure below.



After clicking the IE logo, the screen will appear as shown below.



Click the blue icon pointed to in the figure above. This will cause the Dialog Box below to be displayed where you must enter the URL of products that require the use of the extension.

Enter the URL and click the Add button for each URL.



Click the OK button to complete the configuration.
